Bavarian Blast Parade Rules

1. All units must complete an entry form to be considered for participation in the Bavarian Blast Parade.
2. All units are requested to be lined up and in position one (1) hour prior to the start of the parade which will be at precisely 12:30 P.M. We request that all other vehicles not in the parade be removed from the parade line up area and the parade route one hour prior to the parade.
3. Alcoholic beverages will not be allowed in any parade unit. Violators will be ticketed under the open container law.
4. Throwing candy or any other items from parade units is not allowed. Any items to be distributed must be handed to the person for whom they are intended for the safety of all concerned. Violators will be asked to leave the parade and will be excluded from future parades. Safety is our main concern and our parade insurance is invalid if we allow the throwing of anything from parade units.
5. Squirt guns or the throwing of water will not be tolerated in the parade.
6. Each participant or unit shall be responsible for its own equipment, props, signs, costumes and mode of transportation in the parade and after the parade unless prior arrangements have been made with Bavarian Blast.
7. All animal units or any unit littering the parade route must be accompanied by their own clean-up personnel.
8. Performer shall not be liable to Bavarian Blast for failure to appear or perform by reason of illness or physical disability of the participants, strikes, epidemic, or interruption or delay of transportation, however parade registration fees in such cases cannot be refunded.
9. Bavarian Blast shall at all times have complete supervision, direction and control over the services of performers and expressly reserves the right to control the manner, means and details of the performance of services of the performer.
10. The use of sirens by vehicles so equipped is strictly prohibited by local ordinance along the parade route, prior to, during, and after the parade. Sirens are to be used by emergency vehicles during bona fide emergencies only.
11. Units may not stop along the parade route and must maintain a maximum of two car length spacing between you and the unit in front of you.

We request that all participants consider **safety** as their prime concern along the parade route.
